

Faculty Recognition & Awards Committee Standing Rules Revisions

Proposed Revisions

The Faculty Recognition and Awards Committee formulates policies concerning the recognition of outstanding persons, including ~~deserving Faculty members,~~ solicits ~~and suggests candidates for recognition~~ **reviews award nomination packets and selects award recipients, reviews and recommends approval or denial of potential new awards, participates in the selection of the Honorary Doctorate,** and makes its recommendations to the Executive Committee of the Faculty Senate. ~~and,~~ **Honorary Doctorate recommendations are forwarded** to the Executive **Provost's** Office.

The Committee shall consist of six Faculty members, one of whom may be retired, and one Student representative **member**.

~~A member of the Advancement of Teaching Committee shall participate in the selection of the Elizabeth P. Ritchie Distinguished Professor Award, the OSU Outreach and Engagement Award, the Richard M. Bressler Senior Faculty Teaching Award, and the OSU Faculty Teaching Excellence Award; a member of the Academic Advising Council shall participate in the selection of the Dar Reese Excellence in Advising Award and the OSU Academic Advising Award; a member of the awards committee from the OSU Alumni Association Board of Directors shall participate in the selection of the OSU Alumni Association Distinguished Professor Award; a representative from both the Research Office and University Relations and Marketing shall participate in the selection of the OSU Impact Award for Outstanding Scholarship; and a member of the Research Council shall participate in the selection of the Promising Scholar Award.~~

Rationale:

- *The committee does not actually solicit or suggest candidates for recognition; the Faculty Senate staff does this after consulting with the Provost's Office and other entities that fund the awards.*
- *The blue text in the first paragraph reflects current practice.*
- *Students are referred to as 'members,' rather than 'representatives,' in other committees' Standing Rules. This change will ensure consistency among committees.*
- *The deleted material has been moved to the committee's Internal Guidelines. This will prevent the need to receive Faculty Senate approval whenever an award sponsor requests to participate in the review and selection of award recipients or if an award is created or discontinued.*
- *All of the committee members have reviewed and agreed to the proposed revisions.*

Proposed Clean Version

The Faculty Recognition and Awards Committee formulates policies concerning the recognition of outstanding persons, reviews award nomination packets and selects award recipients, reviews and recommends approval or denial of potential new awards, participates in the selection of the Honorary Doctorate, and makes its recommendations to the Executive Committee of the Faculty Senate. The Committee shall consist of six Faculty members, one of whom may be retired, and one Student representative.

A member of the Advancement of Teaching Committee shall participate in the selection of the Elizabeth P. Ritchie Distinguished Professor Award, the OSU Outreach and Engagement Award, the Richard M. Bressler Senior Faculty Teaching Award, and the OSU Faculty Teaching Excellence Award; a member of the Academic Advising Council shall participate in the selection of the Dar Reese Excellence in Advising Award and the OSU Academic Advising Award; a member of the awards committee from the OSU Alumni Association Board of Directors shall participate in the selection of the OSU Alumni Association Distinguished Professor Award; a representative from both the Research Office and University Relations and Marketing shall participate in the selection of the OSU Impact Award for Outstanding Scholarship; and a member of the Research Council shall participate in the selection of the Promising Scholar Award.

Faculty Recognition and Awards Committee Internal Guidelines

Proposed

The purpose of the Faculty Recognition and Awards Committee is to review award nomination packets and select award recipients for all-university awards typically given during University Day, participate in the selection of the Honorary Doctorate recipient, and review and recommend approval or denial of potential new awards.

Reviewing Nomination Packets and Selecting Award Recipients

When reviewing award nomination packets and selecting award recipients for all-university awards typically given during University Day, the following external reviewers shall be invited to participate:

- A member of the Advancement of Teaching Committee shall participate in the selection of the Elizabeth P. Ritchie Distinguished Professor Award, the OSU Outreach and Engagement Award, the Richard M. Bressler Senior Faculty Teaching Award, and the OSU Faculty Teaching Excellence Award;
- A member of the Academic Advising Council shall participate in the selection of the Dar Reese Excellence in Advising Award and the OSU Academic Advising Award;
- A member of the awards committee from the OSU Alumni Association Board of Directors shall participate in the selection of the OSU Alumni Association Distinguished Professor Award;
- A representative from both the Research Office and University Relations and Marketing shall participate in the selection of the OSU Impact Award for Outstanding Scholarship;
- A member of the Research Council shall participate in the selection of the Promising Scholar Award; and
- A representative from the Research Office shall participate in the selection of the Faculty Innovator Award and Industry Partnering Award.

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
