Promotion to the rank of Associate Professor (Teaching) is based upon evidence of the candidate's:

- High level of effectiveness in teaching and mentoring as assigned;
- High level of effectiveness in the application of curricular design and development or pedagogical strategies and practices;
- Achievement in scholarship and creative activity that contributes to pedagogical advances or advances in the candidate's field(s) of expertise;
- Appropriate level and balance of institutional and professional service.

Promotion to the rank of Professor (Teaching), is based upon evidence of the candidate's:

- Sustained high level of effectiveness in teaching and mentoring as assigned;
- Sustained high level of effectiveness in the application of curricular design and development or pedagogical strategies and practices;
- Sustained achievement in scholarship and creative activity that contributes to pedagogical advances or advances in the candidate's field(s) of expertise;
- Exemplary levels of institutional and professional service, with an appropriate balance between the two.

### **Promotional Criteria for Clinical Professor**

Promotion to the rank of Clinical Associate Professor is based on evidence of the candidate's:

- High level of effectiveness in clinical activities as assigned;
- High level of effectiveness in teaching, advising, or other assigned duties;
- Achievement in scholarship and creative activity that contribute to the body of knowledge or application and dissemination in the candidate's field(s) of expertise;
- Appropriate level and balance of institutional and professional service.

Promotion to the rank of Clinical Professor is based on evidence of the candidate's:

- Sustained high level of effectiveness in clinical activities as assigned;
- Sustained high level of effectiveness in teaching, advising, or other assigned duties;
- Sustained achievement in scholarship and creative activity that contributes to the body of knowledge or application and dissemination in the candidate's field(s) of expertise;
- Exemplary levels of institutional and professional service, and an appropriate balance between the two.
