Proposal to Discharge the Faculty Senate Faculty Welfare Committee

Role: The Faculty Senate Faculty Welfare Committee was established to protect the interests of all faculty, including teaching and research faculty and professional faculty. The Committee is expected to examine relevant existing policies and processes, formulate statements of policy, and advise on programs that affect the economic benefits of both active and retired faculty.

Rationale to discharge: The Committee has been inactive for years. Further, there is considerable overlap between the work of this committee and United Academics of Oregon State University (UAOSU).

Note: The Faculty Senate Professional Faculty Interests Committee, which is very active, serves a similar role focused on those faculty not represented by UAOSU.

Proposal: To discharge the Faculty Senate Faculty Welfare Committee effective immediately.
