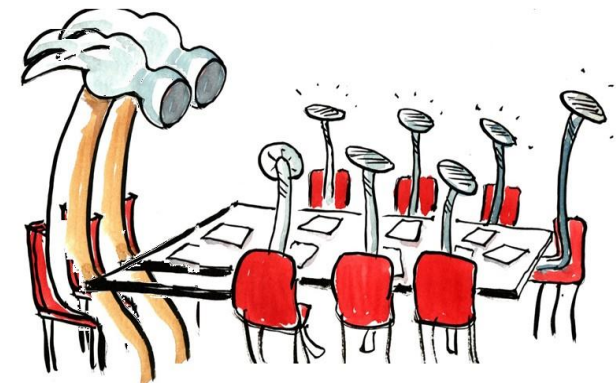

Termination of Academic Unit (CPS #108435)

- College of Business
- Drop the School of Design and Human Environment
- In Fall 2015, all faculty were moved from the school and the design programs are run as programs within the College of Business, similar to the other programs. The School has not been used since.
- In the reorganization of the College and creation of three new Schools (CPS #108414), the design programs and faculty were moved to the School of Marketing, Analytics, and Design.

Supply Chain & Logistics Management

BS, HBS – New UG Major (CIM Key #676)

- College of Business
School of Management, Entrepreneurship, and Supply Chain
- A focused exploration of the analytics aspects of supply chain management. Supports a rapidly-growing interest from organizations for people that can understand and apply SCLM analytics tools and principles.
- All existing and new coursework will be delivered by the same faculty who currently deliver courses in the SCLM option within the Business Administration degree program.

Artificial Intelligence – New Graduate Degree (CPS #107212)

- College of Engineering
School of Electrical Engineering and Computer Science
- Ph.D., M.S., M. Eng. and Graduate Minor
- A research-focused program. By moving to its own degree program, students will take additional topics relevant to their research with the goal of developing interdisciplinary research.
- Sufficient resources in the School of EECS and the CoE to start the program. Additional faculty will be added over time.

Energy Policy Online Graduate Certificate (CPS #106319)

- College of Liberal Arts, School of Public Policy
- New graduate certificate program
- An 18-credit multi-disciplinary program – 2 required core courses, a capstone writing experience, and 8 or more credits of electives. Most courses in the certificate are already available, and students who enter this program can continue on to the Masters in Public Policy.

Yoga Studies and Yoga Teacher Training – New UG Certificate (CPS #107557)

- College of Liberal Arts, School of History, Philosophy, and Religion
- A distinctive program that combines yoga praxis and instruction with academic accountability and a scholarly approach to yoga.
- Most courses in the certificate are already available; several new courses are being developed.
- Expect that additional tuition revenue will offset the cost of new instructors and, if enrollment projections are correct, revenue should exceed instructional cost by year two.
