Baccalaureate Core Committee Double Listed Policy

Policy: No Single course shall be approved for inclusion in multiple categories

Rationale:

The mission of the Baccalaureate Core is to provide a broad and inclusive curriculum for all students across several key areas so all of our students have a strong foundation of understanding of the modern world and ethical citizenship. The Baccalaureate Core requires a minimum of three credits in each area. A course that tries to fulfill two or more categories is, by definition, providing less attention to each outcome. Courses spanning more than one category inevitably sacrifice depth in each category in order to meet the learning outcomes of multiple categories.
