SUBJECT: Faculty Senate Consideration of Degree Candidates

Please accept my request to attend the Faculty Senate meeting on Thursday, June 9, 2016 and present the recommended lists of 2015-2016 degree candidates for Senate approval.

Each year, the Office of the Registrar is pleased to present to the Faculty Senate the candidates for baccalaureate and advanced degrees and those who qualify for various honors. Today we seek your approval for the Class of 2016 – Oregon State University's 147th class.

The final degree auditing and confirmation process is as follows:

All candidates who completed degree requirements Summer, Fall or Winter terms have been certified as meeting all requirements for their respective degrees.

Spring term candidates are taking their final examinations this week. Following submission of grades by the faculty, the Office of the Registrar will finalize the status for all degrees and will forward exact figures to the Senate. The Office of the Registrar checks for completion of all institutional graduation requirements, while the academic dean's offices are responsible for checking the Baccalaureate Core Requirements as well as all college and departmental requirements.

All candidates recommended for the Baccalaureate degree will have satisfied all requirements, except where petitions for waiver of institutional requirements have been approved by the Academic Requirements Committee- a committee of the Faculty Senate, and/or a waiver of college or departmental requirements have been approved by the candidate's dean.

Advanced degree candidates are reviewed and approved by the Dean of the Graduate School in accordance with Graduate Council guidelines.

Oregon State University's Class of 2016 consists of 6406 students who are candidates for 6723 degrees- once again, our biggest class EVER. This includes:

5278 Bachelors degrees

1047 Masters degrees 247 Doctors degrees

151 Professional Doctor degrees 295 students are candidates for 2 degrees And 11 students are candidates for 3 degrees

Again this year, baccalaureate degree candidates can graduate with Academic Distinction. The Class of 2016 has 1218 seniors who qualify for this recognition by maintaining high scholarship in their respective colleges while attending Oregon State University.

557 graduate "cum laude" (gpa 3.50 – 3.69) 346 graduate "magna cum laude" (gpa 3.70 – 3.84) 315 graduate "summa cum laude" (gpa 3.85+)

We recommend these candidates to you for approval of the appropriate degree and honors subject to final confirmation of all degree requirements.
