EXTEND TO ECAMPUS OR PORTLAND CENTER – HYBRID

Any academic degree program that exists in the OSU Catalog must be aligned across all modalities (i.e., existing curricular requirements and academic degree program learning outcomes must be the same).

Ecampus (online) and Portland Center (hybrid) extensions follow an expedited approval path for majors, minors, and options.

Review Steps

- 1. Academic Unit: online course development including MOU with Ecampus
- 2. Ecampus: proposal preparation and submission in CIM
- 3. Academic Programs and Assessment: review
- 4. Catalog Coordinator: review
- 5. Faculty Senate Graduate Council: (graduate programs only) notification and review
- 6. Faculty Senate Curriculum Council: notification and review
- 7. Faculty Senate Executive Committee: notification and review
- 8. Provost (or designee): review and approval
- 9. NWCCU: review and approval

EXTEND EXISTING ACADEMIC DEGREE OR CERTIFICATE TO OSU-CASCADES:

Any academic program that exists in the OSU Catalog must be aligned across all locations and modalities (i.e. existing curricular requirements and academic degree program outcomes must be the same).

A full program proposal is required per HECC requirements for programs delivered more than 40 miles from the main campus if 51% or more of the program will be delivered face-to-face.
