


UHC AY 2014 Operational Highlights

New and Continuing Students

2065 applicants from 642 high schools and 83 universities (30% offer rate)

• 992 students enrolled in UHC this fall (largest student enrollment in UHC

history)








- Academic Programming
 - UHC program requirements modified to increase program flexibility for all students
 - Course expansion (2 new multi-year course agreements with SWLF and SLCS and full Honors biology)

- Tuition Policy
 - UHC differential tuition (DT) is now included as part of UHC students' cost of attendance in financial aid calculations
 - Enables the student's financial aid packet to be adjusted for DT without student having to manually initiate the process
 - Consistent with process used by other colleges with DT
 - Ensures equitable awarding of financial aid
 - Eliminates DT waiver request process
