UHC Operational Highlights

- Tuition Policy
 - UHC differential tuition (DT) is now included as part of UHC students' cost of attendance in financial aid calculations
 - Enables the student's financial aid packet to be adjusted for DT without student having to manually initiate the process
 - Consistent with process used by other colleges with DT
 - Ensures equitable awarding of financial aid
 - Eliminates DT waiver request process

UHC Operational Highlights

- Facilities
 - SLUG relocated to accommodate seismic retrofits in STAG, which begin January 2014
 - Plans underway for transition to 2nd floor Weniger Hall in Summer 2014
 - New UHC space in classroom building construction began in August. Target move in date of Fall 2015
 - Sackett Hall LLC proposal under review by OSUF
